Conflict Minerals Statement

The management and staff of [E³] Engstler Elektronik Entwicklung GmbH have been working with our supply chain to comply with HR 4173 (the Dodd-Frank law), specifically with regard to section 1502 – Conflict Minerals.

Beginning May 31, 2014, many of our customers must begin reporting the use of minerals sourced in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or an adjoining country. The minerals affected are gold, tin, tantalum, and tungsten.

Although [E³] does not add any conflict minerals in our manufacturing process, some of the components or sub-assemblies sourced in our supply chain contain gold; they do not contain the other conflict minerals.

We have completed the process of our annual determination to confirm that none of our products that contain gold use minerals sourced in DRC or surrounding countries, and completed the due diligence in our supply chain. We have done this in order to respond to requests for this information from our customers who are obligated to report under this legislation. This effort is referred to as a Reasonable Country of Origin Inquiry (RCOI). We have completed the process of collecting the appropriate information from our supply chain and are now in the position to respond to requests by providing EICC-GESI declarations for the products we produce.
